AFFIRMATION OF CONFORMANCE

European Union Restriction of Hazardous Substances

Currently, all products produced by Sun Hydraulics "Sun" conform to the EU Restriction of Hazardous Substances Directive 2011/65/EU, as amended by 2015/863/EU.

The EU Restriction of Hazardous Substances ("RoHS") Directive restricts the use of certain hazardous materials in electrical equipment designed for use with a voltage rating not exceeding 1000 Vac and 1500 Vdc. The intent of this Directive is to discourage the use of certain hazardous materials in electrical/electronic equipment to combat environmental pollution, and to protect human health.

While data is expressed in good faith, suppliers and producers may exempt substances or impurities for proprietary purposes, and all pending regulations or in process changes to chemical substance lists may not be reflected in this edition.

When Sun product is used as a component for an end-product which may be subject to the Directive, Sun affirms compliance with the above-stated lists, including exemptions; however, Sun encourages downstream users to review and understand the applicability of all regulations.

As Sun will continue to monitor the development of the materials lists, this statement shall remain in effect until the expiration of the exemptions **or** a change to the materials lists or legislation, whichever comes first.
